2024 LOFY Outstanding Youth Award Contest Rules

1. Contest Topic: "The Impact of Climate Change: A Complex Issue"

Climate change impacts are seen throughout every aspect of the world we live in. It's interrelated on different sectors of society. Things that we depend upon and value such as water, energy, transportation, wildlife, agriculture, ecosystems and human health are experiencing the effects of a changing climate. Drought can harm food production and human health. Flooding can lead to spread of diseases. Human health issues can increase mortality. Climate change impacts differ between neighborhoods or individuals. So, what can we do about it and how should we cope with climate change?

In this essay, the contestant should reflect on different environmental issues, what causes these issues and what solution(s) recommend by expert to limit the negative outcomes of climate change. The essay must be well organized, have good vocabulary and conform to required length.

2. Contest Rules

- a. Contestant shall be evaluated based on a 750 to 1,000 words essay, biographical information statement, community service, leadership experience and participation, three Letter of Recommendation, high school grade point average, and a personal interview.
- b. The following criteria shall be used for judging the contestant:
 - i. 5% Grade point average from school transcript.
 - ii. 15% Three letter of recommendation.
 - iii. 15% On the 750 to 1,000 words essay on the topic of the contest given.
 - iv. 35% Biographical information statement, community service, and leadership experience and participation information.
 - v. 30% Personal interview, opinion may include matters on current local, state, national, or global events.
- c. Judges shall be persons who are knowledgeable about the area related to the topic (i.e., climate change) community service, high school leadership, and a Lion leadership who is not related to the contestant nor belongs to the sponsoring Club.
- d. All contests shall be conducted in English language.
- e. Order of appearance before the judging panel will be determined in advance at the direction of the District LOFY Chair.
- f. Contestant will not give any self-introduction, but shall state their name prior to be interviewed.

3. Awards

- 1. Certificates and scholarship awards will be given to 1st place and 2nd Place winners.
- 2. When there's only one contestant, no monetary award will be given, however, contestant will be eligible to advance to MD-2 State level contest.
- 3. To collect the scholarship award, the Contestant must complete the following process:

- i. Contestant winner must complete the **Scholarship Request Form** available on District's <u>website https://lionsdistrict2x1.org/forms/</u>) along with **proof of registration** information from a university, college, junior college, or vocational school.
- ii. The information should be sent along with any supplemental information needed by the institution (i.e., scholarship forms, etc). Send request for payment to:

- 4. Scholarship award will be **paid directly to the designated scholarship/financial aid/bursar office** of the designated school.
- 5. The scholarship award must be collected no later than two years following the recipient's graduation from High School.

4. Rules of Eligibility for Contestant

- 1. Contestant <u>must</u> be sponsored by a Lion Club from District 2-X1.
- 2. A Club may sponsor only **one contestant for each contest** by submitting contest entry application, associated documents, and the entry fee ('application packet') to District's Contest Chair.
- 3. Contestant <u>must</u> be junior or senior high school.
- 4. Contestant <u>must</u> be or have been a regularly enrolled student in a public school or comparable educational program located in Texas.
- 5. A false statement on the entry application or associated document, causes disqualification with the entry fee being forfeited.
- 6. There shall be *no refund* on any entry fee.
- 7. A contestant can applied for multiple contests at both District and State MD-2 level.

5. Responsibility of Contestant

- a. Each Contestant <u>shall required to submit</u> to the sponsoring <u>Lions Club</u> all in the application packet:
 - i. Completed **District 2-X1 Contest Application** form which can be found on District's website https://lionsdistrict2x1.org/forms/
 - ii. Two (2) high quality, passport/wallet size, glossy, color, photographs (such as current school picture.)
 - iii. Four (4) copies of typed, double-spaced essay with word counts on the last page of the essay for judging, publication, and promotion purposes. Essay's topic has to be the same with the topic given.
 - iv. Four (4) copies each for typed biographical information statement, community service, and leadership experience and participation.
 - v. Four (4) copies of three (3) Letter of Recommendation.
 - vi. One (1) **original and certified** high school transcript, plus three (3) copies.
 - vii. Signed Contestant's Code of Conduct* form.
 - viii. Signed **Chaperone Guidelines*** form.

- ix. Signed **Medical Power of Attorney*** form, designating contestant's Chaperone as Primary Responsible Party.

- b. Fail to send ALL items above will result in disqualification.
- c. All contestants must be able to participate in this contest using **online live audio and video** communication via **Zoom** on **Saturday**, **March 23**, **2024** starting at **1 PM**.
- d. Prior to the Contest, contestants, parents, and their Club sponsors will be provided with additional instruction for the online contests to be used by the Contest Chair on Fri., March 15, 2024.

e. Basic guidelines for virtual contest:

- i. Contestants must have computer or access to a computer with a wi-fi connection, video capability (webcam) and microphone to ensure that contestant's gestures and facial expression will be capture by their camera and their voice will be clearly captured by the microphone while delivering their essay or speech.
- ii. Contestants will be sent an email invitation by Contest Chair to participate in the contest and be ready at their designated time.
- iii. Contestants must wear business attire for the online contest.
- iv. Contestants' speaking area:
 - (a) must be free of distraction, noise and if necessary, the Contest Chair will advice contestants on additional lighting needs.
 - (b) should allow for maximum view of contestant without sacrificing audio quality while presenting their essay or speech.
- v. Once contestant presents their essay or speech, they will be placed in the waiting room until the conclusion of the contest.
- vi. If technology fails during the contest and the LOFY Chair determines that the contest can no longer continue, the Contest Chair may pause the contest until the technology issue is resolved. A contestant may resume their essay or speech at the point at which the technology failed.
- vii. After the conclusion of the contest and the results have been determined, all contestants will be admitted to rejoin the online contest room, at which time the winners will be announced by the Contest Chair.
- viii. All contestants will be recognized and receive certificate of participation. In addition to scholarship awards, 1st and 2nd place winners will receive an award and a winner certificates.
- ix. Contestant who win 1st place maybe ask by District Governor to read his or her essay on speech in person at District 2-X1 Convention, Saturday, April 13, 2024 and will advance to MD-2 State level contest.
- x. If the 1st placed winner contestant is unable to participate in the MD-2 Contest, District 2-X1 LOFY Chair-with MD-2 State OFY Contest Chairman approval, will advance the 2nd Place winner to MD-2 Contest instead.
- xi. Contestant who will advance to MD-2 State Contest (as stated in items ix and x above) will be contacted by MD-2 Contest Coordinator regarding detail information for:
 - i. Virtual Contest Orientation on Saturday, April 27, 2024.

- ii. Virtual MD-2 State OFY Contest on Saturday, May 4, 2024.
- xii. Contestant who win 1st Place at State Contest level must agree to attend MD-2 Opportunity for Youth Luncheon, Saturday, May 18, 2024 in Amarillo, TX and participate in Lions of Texas MD-2 events and activities during the period immediately after the contest until the end of the following year's contest. If this contestant is unable to attend, unless there is a medical or family emergency, the State Convention will forfeit their scholarship award. High school graduation or any school trip do not qualify as an emergency.

6. Responsibility of the Sponsoring Club

- a. Where do we find contestant(s)?
 - Family, friends or colleague who live on the same area/state.
 - School principals, counselors, and/or Science and English teachers.
 - Youth Groups and Youth Programs (Leo Club, YMCA, Boy or Girl Scouts, etc.).
- b. An entry fee of \$100 per contestant to be attached to each participant's application packet, payable to '2-X1 Charities Inc.'
- c. Sponsoring Club must ensure all documents listed above (application packet, see 5.a. i. to 5.a.ix.) are completed for each contestant, have all requirement signatures, and are sent to the Contest Chair listed in this Contest Rules. Deadline postmark will be Friday, March 1, 2024.
- d. Complete the "Contestant Checklist" (check mark all the boxes) place it on top of the completed application packet. The form is available on District's <u>website https://lionsdistrict2x1.org/forms/.</u>
- e. At the State level contest, chaperon/sponsoring Club *must* comply with requirements as set forth in the MD-2 Lions of Texas OFY Contest's Chaperone Guidelines as stated on MD-2 website https://texaslions.org/outstanding-youth-award/.

- Fri., March 15, 2024 Contestant acceptance and additional instruction (Zoom Link).
- Sat., March 23, 2024 Speech Judging via Zoom starting at 1 PM and
 - Winner announcement.
- Sat., April 13, 2024 1st Place Winner speech presentation at District Convention, TBA.
- Sat., April 27, 2024 MD-2 Contest Orientation.
- Sat., May 4, 2024. MD-2 Virtual Contests.
- Sat., May 18, 2024 MD-2 Lions of Texas State Convention in Amarillo, TX.
