The "District 2-X1 Lions University" for the upcoming Lion year is scheduled for June 21, 2025. Details will be forthcoming but <u>save the date and plan to get your club's incoming officers there for in-person training</u>.

One of our 2024-2025 district goals is for 65% of Club Presidents, Club Secretaries, and Club Treasurers to have received training. As of today, of our 68 clubs, 67.65% of Club Presidents, 55.88% of Club Secretaries, and 50.0% of Club Treasurers have taken advantage of one of the training opportunities for this Lion year. Clubs run smoother and have fewer issues if their officers know what they should be doing. Hopefully more of the current club's officers who have yet to receive training will receive it today at the Mid-Winter Breakouts.

An alternative training method allows self-study training. The requirements were posted on the District 2-X1 Lions University page and involved completing between 4 courses for Presidents), 2 courses for Secretaries, and 1 course for Treasurers available on the <a href="https://lionsuniversity.org/bachelors/">https://lionsuniversity.org/bachelors/</a> (USA/Canada Lions University web site) plus reviewing the important officer documents available on the District LU page <a href="https://lionsdistrict2x1.org/lions-2-x1-university-files/">https://lionsdistrict2x1.org/lions-2-x1-university-files/</a>. Two Lions have completed this method of training to date.
