

## Service Activities Action Plan

**Goal Statement:** To increase the impact and relevance of service in District 2-X1, raise awareness of club service, and attract prospective members, our team will ensure **80% of Lion and Leo clubs report service**, focusing especially on the global causes of **Diabetes and Environment** during the 2025–2026 Lions year. **For the 2024-2025 year, District 2x-1 will set a goal of serving 500,000 people.**



2-X1 has exceed its service goals for the last three years. We served over 684,000 in 2024-2025. We have set a realistic and achievable goal of serving 500,000 in the year 2025-26.



## LCIF Action Plan

**Goal Statement:** Increase **individual participation** in LCIF donations by **8%** and **club participation** by **5%**, supporting LCIF’s global humanitarian efforts and fundraising goals. In total, District 2x-1 have set the goal to raise \$65,000 in LCIF donation.



2-X1 LCIF donations in year 2024-2025 were over \$57,000. A realistic goal of \$65,000 has been set for the year 2025-26.
