Central Region Activities:

- Currently communicating/contacting all Zone Chairs in Central Region on a regular basis.
- Make sure all Zones/Clubs receiving information communicated from District Governor and all other District Leaders
- All Zones in Central Region are completed the First and Second Zone Meetings with successfully with the participation of all clubs /Majority of clubs under their Zone. Currently we are working to schedule the third zone meeting.
- We focused Service activities in our first Zone Meeting & Membership on the Second Zone meeting and covered new standards concerning service projects /new membership requirements for club excellence awards. Also covered the new requirements and changes for getting the Club Excellence Award for 25-26 Lion year.
- As of December 31st -2025, Central Region has a total of 888 members, reflecting a net gain of 29 members over the past six months. Zone 6 showed excellent growth with +55 members (due to adding two new clubs in zone 6), followed by Zone 8 with + 8 members. We are actively working to achieve positive net growth in Zone 5 and Zone 7 as well.
- During our Second Zone Meetings. We had in-depth and productive discussions on the importance of membership growth. Along with effective strategies to recruit new members and retain existing ones. These meetings provided valuable ideas and motivation to strengthen our clubs and move toward sustained growth across all Zones.
- Zone chairs are visiting their club/ in the process of scheduling the club visits and leading the service projects in their respective areas.
- All Zone Chairs in the Central Region are doing a commendable work in coordinating and supporting their clubs under their zones/ as needed to meet the District Governors Goal for this Lion year
