

“FLASH - DISTRICT CONVENTION IMPORTANT VOTING NEWS” - Lions Clubs International has its “Eyes on District 2-X1” voting for our International Director Candidate PCC John Landrum!

We need 100% of our District Club voting delegates from each of our Clubs to be at our District Convention in Duncanville on Saturday, April 25, 2026, at 2 p.m. to vote. All you have to do is register in advance at no cost and show up to vote, whether you are a delegate or alternate delegate.

Why? It is Very Important, specifically, that our District has one of our own Lions endorsed by our District as a candidate for International Director of Lions Clubs International – PCC John Landrum. We need to get him elected! Our District has not had an elected International Director Representative on the LCI Board of Directors representing our District and all Lions in MD-2 Texas since 1952. We also have other District officers and Directors of our charities that must be elected to their positions.
