### Central Region Activities.

The Central Region continues to remain active with strong participation, coordination, and communication across all Zones and Clubs. Regular contact is maintained with all Zone Chairs to ensure effective dissemination of information from the District Governor and District Leadership.

All Zones have successfully completed their **First and Second Zone Meetings**, with participation from all or the majority of clubs.

- The **First Zone Meeting** focused on **Service Activities**.
- The **Second Zone Meeting** emphasized **Membership Growth**, including new standards for service projects and updated requirements for the **Club Excellence Award (2025–2026 Lion Year)**.

During the upcoming **Third Zone Meetings**, the **primary focus area will be Leadership Development**, aimed at strengthening future leaders and enhancing overall organizational effectiveness.

### Membership Growth

As of March 9, 2026, the Central Region has a total of **957 members**, reflecting a **net gain of 48 members** over the past nine months.

- **Zone 6:** +63 members (notable growth due to the addition of two new clubs)
- **Zone 8:** +4 members
- **Zone 7:** +2 members
- **Zone 5:** Actively working toward positive growth

Second Zone Meetings included in-depth discussions on membership growth, focusing on **recruitment strategies, retention efforts, and sustainable club development**.
